

HERTFORD HEATH PUSHCHAIR WALK

No.4. 2¾M / 4½K

A nice out and back walk often overlooked, it is straight and even in bad weather it is always walkable, also good for the youngsters to try out their bike skills.

You can start in the village and walk to the Jolly Pinder **J** (or from the village hall **L**) with the PH. on your right walk along the tarmac Bridleway to the last house and you arrive at a T junction of Bridleways **K**, turn left and you are on Ermine Street an old Roman Road, now called Elbow Lane, just do what the Romans did and march ahead till you reach a public road called Lord Street, turn around and just stroll back, youngsters can have a good time, just mind the occasional horse rider or the serious mountain biker, but they are very few, in the weekdays you will see more deer than bikers.

The distance from the village hall **L** is about the same, the only difference is you are on the Roman Road all the time.

You do not have to walk to the end, you can turn around anytime.
