Hertford Heath Buggy Club would like all your unwanted toys, clothes, odds and ends that we could sell at a car boot sale and raise some much needed cash for the club.

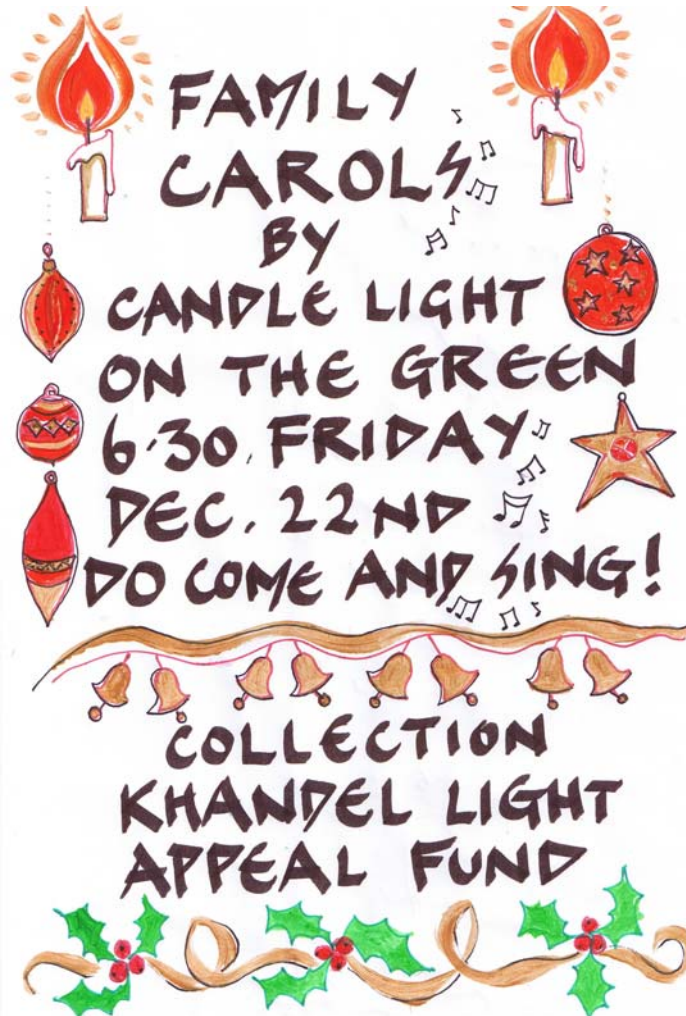
