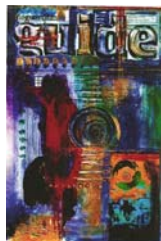

### BEACON COURT PROPOSALS

Riversmead's application is likely to be decided at the meeting of East Herts' Development Control Committee on 10<sup>th</sup> February. This meeting will be held in the Waytemore Room, The Causeway, Bishop's Stortford.

The Parish Council and a number of residents wrote in objection to Riversmead's plans. East Herts does allow residents to speak at these meetings but usually insists on only one opponent and one proponent who each have only three minutes to make their points. The Parish Council is liaising with all objectors on how best to make all the salient points to the Committee in that very limited time.

The Parish Council should know the officers' recommendations before the next Parish Council meeting and will write to all members of the Development Control Committee shortly before its meeting to express the Parish Council's, and the village's, concerns about how Riversmead took the decisions both to demolish Beacon Court and on what to build in its place without any consultation whatsoever.

## SPORTS PROGRAMME

Hertford Heath Youth Club is working together with Pro-Action and Child UK to introduce an 8 week sports programme which aims to build upon the current activities run by the Club, increasing young people's confidence and creativity through the delivery of multi-sport sessions and art activities.

Qualified coaches will visit Hertford Heath Youth Club for an hour and a half over an 8-week period and deliver sessions unique to the Club designed to engage everyone, as well as using space and our environments productively. The Club is also provided with a large equipment filled sports bag and a Sports and Activities pack.

The Youth Club operates two sessions, the younger group meets on a Wednesday between 18.30hrs -19.30hrs open to all 8 to 10 year olds in the Mission Room and again on a Friday 19.00hrs - 21.00hrs open to 10 -14 years olds in the Village Hall,

However, during the sports programme both groups will be combined together and will be held on the following dates in the Village Hall
