

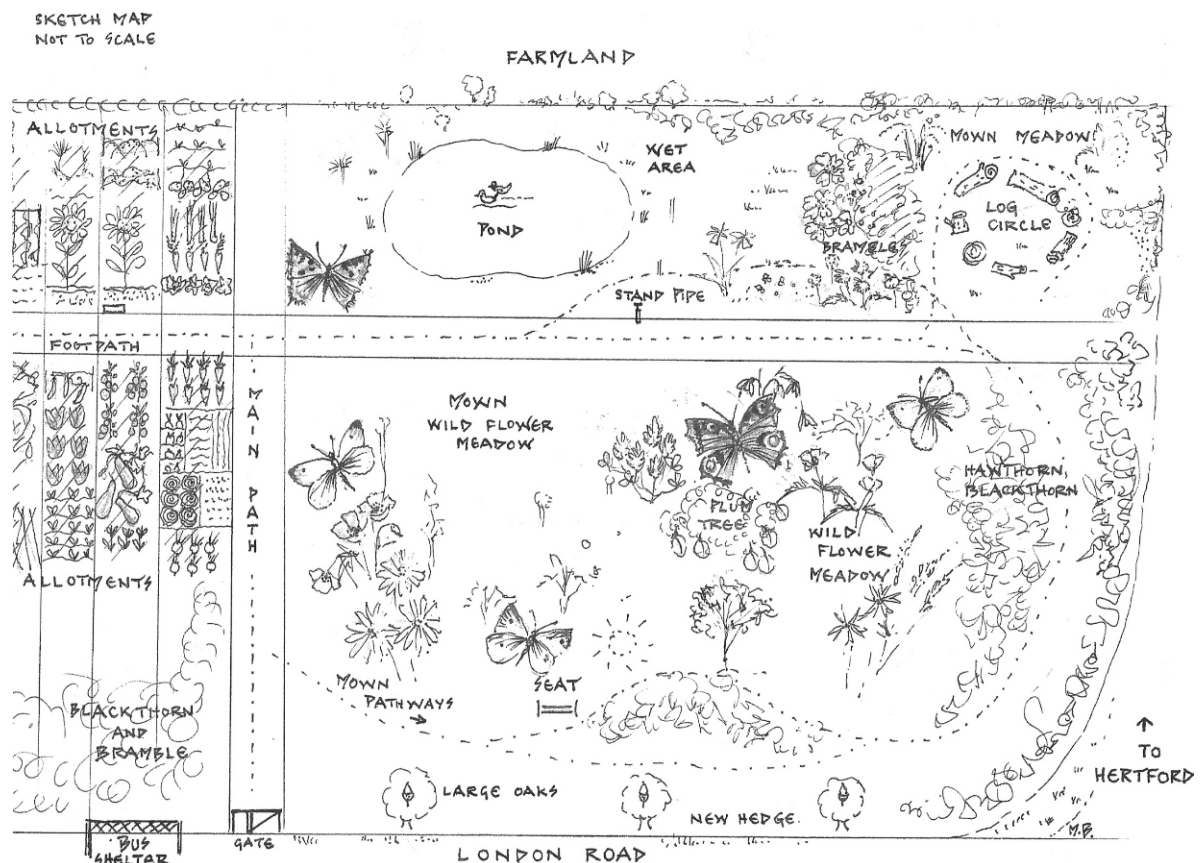

### **UPDATE ON PLAYING FIELD**

The Parish Council is consulting on the recommendation of the National Playing Fields Association that the teenagers' meeting point be relocated to one of three possible sites on the Playing Field. The suggested sites are at the far end of the field, at the other end of the chain-link fence and nearer the path, and in the dip near the new goal post.

Also under investigation is the provision of car parking at the far end of the field, solely for use on match days. The Council has learned that, in order for the Hertford Heath Football Club to progress to a higher league, car parking facilities need to be provided.

A further possible project is the renovation or relocation of the children's play area.
