TERMS OF USE

FOOTBALL HUT

The terms of use refer to the football hut situated on the playing fields off Trinity Rd, Hertford Heath. Hertford Heath Parish Council (HHPC) own both the playing fields and the hut situated therein.

In order for any team or body to use the hut, whether it be for a one-off occasion, short, or long term, the terms of use must be fully accepted and adhered to, with no exception. Any disregard of these terms of use can result in immediate and permanent removal of the right to use the facility.

No additional keys shall be cut to access the football hut. If additional keys are required, an application to HHPC must be made

The holder of each key must be made known to HHPC with full contact details provided to HHPC

HHPC shall hold a key to the hut at all times

The hut will be kept clean and in good order internally, to allow use and access for all users

The hut will retain both water and electricity services at all times. These contracts will be held in HHPC's name, but the costs will be devolved to those bodies utilizing the facility on a regular basis (this will be agreed under separate cover for long term users)

One off use of the hut for an event requires prior permission from HHPC and completion of a booking form at least one month in advance of the event. This will incur a £10 nominal charge to cover utilities and wear and tear, payable in advance

Should HHPC wish to use the hut at any point, this useage will be prioritized over any other

The exterior of the hut will be cleaned and/or painted at least every five years. This cost will be met in full by the parish council

The cost of repair to any damage to the hut will be billed to the team/user responsible

No flammable or otherwise dangerous materials are to be stored in the hut

Any items stored in the hut remain the full responsibility of the owner and must be stored in a fashion which allows continued use of the hut

Faults or other defects must be reported to HHPC as soon as possible
